- Survey questions commonly missed:
  - The usual duration of analgesia of 1-2 mg Morphine IV is 4-5 hours.
    Answer: False
  - Patients who can be distracted from pain usually do not have severe pain.
    Answer: False
  - Opioids should not be used in patients with a history of substance abuse.
    Answer: False
  - Elderly patients cannot tolerate opioids for pain relief. Answer: False
  - The time to peak effect for morphine given IV is: Answer: 15 min
  - The time to peak effect for morphine given orally is: Answer: 1-2 hrs
  - Following abrupt discontinuation of an opioid, physical dependence is manifested by the following: Answer: sweating, yawning, diarrhea and agitation with patients when the opioid is abruptly discontinued.
