INPATIENT NURSING CLINICAL ROTATION BADGE/KEY ACCESS PROCESS

- All Nursing schools participating in a clinical rotation will need to obtain "Key Card Access" from the Security Departments at their assigned Medical Centers prior to beginning their rotation.
- Each Clinical Nursing Instructor will be required to pick up and return the appropriate number of Key Cards for each student as well as themselves.
- Students and Instructors are also required to wear their school picture ID badge.
- Any cards not returned to the Security department following each clinical rotation will be **charged** to the school or the instructor at a cost of \$10.00 per card.
- Key Card access must be obtained at the assigned Medical Center's Security office (see below)
- Ontario Security located in Bldg. C (next to 60 freeway), Central Utility Plant, 2nd floor
- Fontana Security located on the first floor of parking structure 1&2
