

MOBILITY LEVEL TRAINING SAFE PATIENT HANDLING

Safety Magnets quickly identify the # of staff needed to safely handle a patient

Safe Patient Handling is "Using the Right Equipment to assist moving patients at all times."

- Green Light GO is 1-2 person assist
- Orange Light- Think is 1-2 persons assist
- Red Light Stop is 2-3 OR More person assist

GO – Fairly Independent: at least 1-2 person assist





□Level 5

Walks to nurses station (>50 ft.)

□Level 4

Takes a few steps (<50 ft.)

THINK – Moderate Assist: at least 1-2 person





□Level 3

Stands by bed

□Level 2

Sits by bed

STOP – Maximum Assist: at least 2-3 person





□Level 1

Bed Bound

Over 200 lbs.

Assessing the Level of Minimum Staff Assistance

Mobility Level 5 & 4:



Independent/ Supervision: Patient doing at least 75% of the work;

ADLs = bathing, grooming, feeding. May use walker or cane.

Mobility Level 5: Able to Walk >50 ft – Can walk in hallways with supervision/minimal assistance.

Mobility Level 4: Able to Walk <50 ft – Can walk to doorway with supervision/minimal assistance.

Mobility Level 3 & 2:



Minimum to Moderate Assist: Patient are <u>able to sit or stand</u> with partial assistance, requiring 1-2 nurse/lift tech supervision, also known as Mobility Level 2-3.

Mobility Level 3: Able to stand. Able to do a few side-steps with Supervision/Minimal Assistance (may use walker or cane).

Mobility Level 2: Able to sit at the edge of the bed with only Supervision/Minimal Assistance.

Mobility Level 1:



Total to Maximum Assist: Patients are <u>bedbound</u> needing a 2-3 or more nurse/lift tech assist.

Mobility Level 1: You may see illness preventing Active Range of Motion or mobility is unsafe (unstable as determined by MD or RN).
