

COVID 19 Student and Faculty Guidelines for the resumption of Clinical Rotations



Students and faculty, please be aware that COVID-19 patients are receiving care in KP facilities.

Health Screening

- KP is following National, Regional, and local health screening protocols
- Do <u>Not</u> report to clinical setting if experiencing mild to severe symptoms of fever 100°F or greater, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, muscle pain, loss of sense of smell or taste, and/or chills

Personal Protective Equipment

- Follow medical center guidelines and staff protocols for wearing personal 'cover your cough masks' upon entrance into a medical center.
- When working in patient care areas, wear the PPE issued by Kaiser Permanente and appropriate to the clinical situation.
- Students/faculty shall practice good stewardship of all PPE and other supplies

Clinical On-boarding

- All assigned onboarding materials must be completed prior to the start of the clinical rotation.
- Complete all assigned KP Learn Modules including COVID-19 Training; COVID-19 Training Amendment

Considerations

- Students working in the hospital may not care for patients diagnosed with COVID-19 or Persons Under Investigation (PUI) for COVID-19
- Follow KP usual policy for managing exposure to injury for a COVID-19 exposure
- Adhere to the following: practice good hand hygiene; avoid touching your face; practice physical distancing

Social/Physical Distancing

- All reflective sessions, including debriefs, pre and post conferences, and other cohort gatherings are to be conducted virtually and away from the medical center campus.
- There shall be no congregation in common areas, such as hallways, atriums, cafeterias and other open spaces within the medical center prior to, during or post clinical shift
- Physical distancing shall be maintained during meals and breaks
- Social distancing guidelines shall be followed when working in patient care areas.
