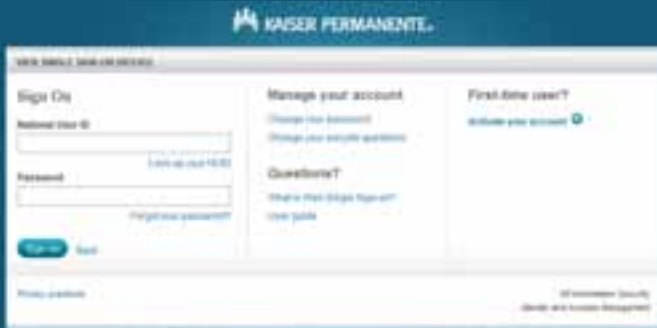


KP HealthStream

Any password changes or resets will be performed by your local IT or "Forgot Your Password" function at <https://idm-uat.kp.org/kpidm/kp/forgotPassword.do>. HealthStream Administrators will no longer reset passwords.

Now using KP Healthstream is easier than ever because you can sign on with KP's Single Sign-On.

One less password and one-click access directly from My HR and Nursing Pathways.

Starting March 20, 2014, Single Sign-On (SSO) will be available on KP HealthStream. You will no longer log in from the original HealthStream website but through Kaiser Permanente SSO.

What is Single Sign-On (SSO)?

Single Sign-On (SSO) provides a way to sign on to multiple websites and web-based applications using a single password together with your National User ID (NUID). Many popular online destinations at Kaiser Permanente are included in the SSO program.

Getting Started with SSO

- ▶ If you already have an account, you can log-in with your NUID and password. This should take you directly to KP HealthStream.
- ▶ If this is your first time using SSO, you'll need to activate your account, by creating a password and choosing security questions.
- ▶ Then, whenever you encounter the sign-on screen, just sign on with your NUID and SSO password to access supported websites and applications.
